DRAFT Bath Abbey Headline Goals for 2023

Focus on TELLING: Proclaiming the Gospel

Called to be "An Attraction helping visitors and locals encounter God's presence and truth; through people, words, music, arts, building and bible" (Mission Action Plan: 2020 Vision)

Already introduced in 2023: new Discovery Centre; new interpretation signage; new free evangelistic booklet & prayer cards; new Audio tours; new hourly guided tours; new Abbey Church info for visitors on TV screens

Host Keynote lectures & seminars on hot topics

- o Eg Climate Change focus (with Gaia exhibition in 2023)
 - explore making this an annual lecture topic, in addition to others
- Eg Modern Slavery focus
- Big name guest speakers, booked well in advance for 2024, 25, 26 ...
- Partner with Universities, other Bath churches, etc etc

Provide a prayer & simple explanation, to go with our candle stands

 Also a specific written prayer for visitor use, updated according to world needs (in Alphege Chapel); and to accompany exhibitions (eg alongside Diptychs, Gaia, etc)

• Provide a photo display about the Abbey Church family

- With a stand of printed congregational info to take away: Welcome cards; ER & stewardship forms;
 Details of groups to join; provision for children/young people; etc
- Include snapshot personal stories of changed lives (local congregation alongside famous Christians)

• Think of something to give every visitor

- o Cf taking away a pebble from the beach, to remember your visit
- o Either to accompany an event/exhibition, or as a permanent feature

DRAFT Bath Abbey Headline Goals for 2024

Focus on TENDING: Caring as a church family

Called to be "An Oasis refreshing lives with hospitality & fun, healing & peace; through welcoming, including and nurturing all who come" (Mission Action Plan: 2020 Vision)

Already planned for 2023/4

With Congregation:

- 1. Resourcing specific pastoral areas eg Hospital visiting; Home Communions; Anna Chaplaincy (care for older members); Welcome with new members; Support for carers; Bereavement visiting; family support.
- 2. Strengthening Contact Groups
- 3. Exploring the training & commissioning of Lay Pastoral Assistants

With City:

- 1. Offer Grief & Loss Bereavement Course
- 2. Develop links/support with Schools & University students

With Congregation

- Focus on care & support for young people, for whom it can be tough being known as a chorister, or as Christian
 - o Pro-actively build relationships with choir families, inc Melody Maker families
 - Eg host social events for them that our clergy & PCC also attend
 - Support struggling parents
 - o Build an increasingly inter-generational church family
 - Support & partner with school chaplains, etc
- Treasure, diversify & enrich our team of volunteers
 - o Aiming to be more multi-generational, more racially diverse, etc
- Hospitality team
 - Follow through on PCC plan to recruit a volunteer team, to plan & staff social events

With City

- Give active prayer support for every group/agency that provides pastoral care across the city
 - o Include all those who are actively "tending" with others (of all faiths and none)
 - Include a Bath group/agency every week in Sunday morning weekly intercessions
 - Contact them for prayer requests (& welcome displays/info, in church and/or on our website)
 - Monitor how those contacts develop, possibly welcoming them for a service, growing active partnerships, etc
